SUBJECT: FYE 2017 Change in Net Position

History

The FY 2016-2017 General Appropriations Act was adopted by the Executive Committee via Resolution 2016-29 on September 22, 2016 with Total Operating Revenues of \$3,718,842, Total Operating Expenses of \$3,851,871, and a budgeted Change in Net Position of (\$133,029). The FYE 2017 budget was amended by the Executive Committee via Resolution 2017-02 on April 13, 2017 to account for the \$1.5 million FMS CGAP grant. The grant revenue flowed from Treasury, through the Authority, and to the participants so both FMS revenues and expenses were increased by \$1.5 million. The budgeted Change in Net Position of (\$133,029) did not change. Finally, the FYE 2017 budget was amended by the Executive Committee via Resolution 2017-12 on September 14, 2017 with Total Operating Revenues of \$5,424,000, Total Operating Expenses of \$5,450,000, and a Change in Net Position of (\$26,000).

FYE 2017 Change in Net Position

The audited financial statements show the Authority ended the year with a (\$215,973) Change in Net Position rather than (\$26,000), a \$189,973 difference. The difference between the budged and actual Change in Net Position is almost completely attributable to the VHWM program. General Fund expenses were nearly 10 percent less than budgeted. General Fund expenses are charged to the FMS and VHWM funds via transfers, so both those funds benefited from this favorable variance. FMS revenues were almost exactly as budgeted, and expenses were nearly two percent less than budgeted. VHWM revenues were nearly \$69,000 (9 percent) less than budgeted and expenses were nearly \$187,000 (23% more than budgeted). Together, these variances account for a \$256,000 negative variance, hence why we ended the program. The attached table shows these variances.
